


THE KEY CHALLENGES

- ✓ EU CEF co-financed "Cold Ironing" Terminal Container Genova Pra'- INES Project (estim. end 2021)
- ✓ EU Interreg co-financed mobile LNG refueling stations "GNL FACILE" Project (estim. end 2021)
- ✓ Installation of photovoltaic systems on the roofs of all the port buildings in the Ports of Genoa/Savona-Vado (estim. end 2022)
- ✓ Energy efficiency interventions and photovoltaic system installation Stazione Marittima (cruise terminal Port of Genoa, estim. end 2021)
- ✓ Smart grid Port of Savona

- Ships repairs currently underway and almost completed
- ✓ Pra' container terminal currently underway and almost completed
- Cruise terminals start up phase
- Savona-Vado cointainer terminal start up phase

- > satisfaction of the urban communities that live really close to the port area





